Dear Parent/ Carer,

As part of the school's drive to make our new Year 7 students feel welcome at Farlingaye and to foster a sense of belonging amongst the year group, I am writing to you with regards to an opportunity for your child to visit Clip 'n Climb in Ipswich. The focus of this morning will be building self-confidence, encouraging teamwork and new friendships, whilst improving students' self-esteem. Students will attend the session with their tutor group offering a great opportunity for them to get to know each other better as well as the chance to celebrate completing their first few weeks at Farlingaye.

Whilst at Clip 'n Climb, students will have both climbing and team building sessions. On the day of their trip, students should come to school in their PE kit. Tutor groups will travel to and from the venue by coach departing school at **9:10 am** and returning to school for **1.00 pm** in time for lunch. The dates of the trips will be as follows:

Tuesday 21 st September	7A, 7R and half of 7N
Wednesday 22 nd September	7F and 7G
Thursday 23 rd September	7I, 7S and half of 7N
Friday 24 th September	7H and 7L

The cost of the visit will be **£20** and should be paid via ParentPay. Due to the date of the trip, there will be a tight turnaround, with the payments being due on **Thursday 16th September**.

Parents are also required to consent to the following when making a payment on ParentPay:

- I consent to my child taking part in this activity and acknowledge that the staff will be liable in the event of any accident only if they have failed to take reasonable care of my child during the visit.
- I consent to my child receiving medical treatment, which in the opinion of a qualified medical practitioner, may be necessary.
- I confirm that the medical/contact information held by the school for my child is up to date.

Please note if you have not yet returned the single consent form from your registration pack, this needs to be completed and returned to school as soon as possible.

We would very much like for all Year 7 students to be able to participate in this trip, so please do contact us if there is any issue with payment as we may be able to help with the cost.

Parents should note that it is school policy that participation on a trip will be dependent on staff feeling confident that your child will behave appropriately. In particular, poor behaviour between now and the date of the trip, is likely to result in your son/daughter being withdrawn from the trip. The decision of the Headteacher on this matter is final.
