Important Information for candidates

The following information explains what may happen following an appeal or enquiry about the result of an examination.

If your examination centre makes an enquiry about the result of one of your examinations after your subject grade has been issued, there are three possible outcomes:

- Your original mark is confirmed as correct. There is no change to your grade.
- Your original mark is raised. Your final grade may be higher than the original grade you received.
- Your original mark is lowered. Your final grade may be lower than the original grade you received.

In order to proceed with the enquiry or appeal, you must sign the form printed overleaf. This tells the Head of Centre that you have understood what the outcome may be, and that you give your consent to the enquiry or appeal being made.

The awarding bodies cannot engage in correspondence with candidates or their parents/guardians relating to review of results procedure.

NB: It is advisable to speak to your subject teacher/head of department before proceeding with a post results service.
