Year 11 Prom – Wednesday 24th June 2026 6.15pm – 11.00pm

You are warmly invited to attend the **Year 11 Prom**, a special evening to celebrate the end of your GCSE journey and the memories we have all made together during your time at school. We are excited to confirm that the prom will be held at **Trinity Park, Ipswich**. It is a very well-regarded venue for proms and other large functions. The excellent package includes a prom parade route for arrivals, red carpet entrance, a two-course meal, DJ, disco, photo booth and a sweet station. Students will be able to choose their meal from the following options:

Main Courses

- **Roast chicken wrapped in bacon, mini roast potatoes, vegetables, and chicken gravy**
- **Pulled pork (buffalo cauliflower wings for veggie option), macaroni cheese, corn cob**

Desserts

- **Chocolate Brownie (DF/GF) with vanilla ice cream and caramel sauce**
- **New York style cheesecake with chocolate sauce**

GF – Gluten Free, DF – Dairy Free

The cost of the Prom is £50. Tickets are available to purchase via ParentPay now. **All tickets must be purchased and paid for in full by Friday 8th May**. Following receipt of full payment, you will be sent a link to select your choice of meal and must inform us of any dietary requirements so that these can be catered for. A photographer will be at the venue taking pictures throughout the evening and a link will be sent after the event should you want to purchase images.

We encourage everyone to dress smartly for the occasion, whether that's a suit, dress, or other formal attire, so we can make the evening feel truly special. The prom parade will commence at 6.15pm. We encourage parents who wish to come and watch to arrive by 6pm and park in the designated parent parking area (unless you are driving a vehicle in the parade). All students must be collected at 10:45pm.

The prom will be a fantastic opportunity to relax, celebrate your achievements, and enjoy an evening with your friends and teachers before everyone moves on to their next chapter. The night will include music, dancing, plenty of photo opportunities and a chance to make memories.

It should be possible for all those who wish to come to do so, but in order to confirm numbers and make arrangements with the venue **all tickets must be purchased by 8th May**.
