We are excited to confirm that the Year 13 Prom to celebrate the end of Sixth Form will be held at Venue 16 on Tuddenham Road, Ipswich. It is a very well-regarded venue for proms, weddings and other large functions. The excellent package includes a welcome drink, two course meal and disco. It was a challenge for the Prom Committee to choose the options from such an extensive menu, but the carefully selected choices will hopefully appeal to all students.

Student's need to choose a main and a dessert.

Main Courses

- **4oz Beef burger** topped with bbq brisket of beef, cheese and bacon in a brioche bun with fries (Can be GF, Can be DF)
- **Hunter's chicken** stuffed with smoked cheddar and wrapped in smoked bacon served with fat chips and tender stem broccoli (GF, can be DF)
- **Vegetable lasagne** served with garlic bread and mixed salad (Can be Vegan)

Desserts

- **Chocolate Brownie** with vanilla ice cream and mixed berries (Can be GF/Vegan)
- **Eton Mess** (GF)
- **Dark Chocolate and Raspberry Cheesecake** with fruit and coulis (Vegan and GF)

GF – Gluten Free, DF – Dairy Free.

The cost of the Prom this year will be £50 which will need to be **paid in full by Friday 17th April**. Payments can only be made using ParentPay, once payment is received Mrs Prior will send a forms link for you to select menu choices and inform us of any dietary requirements. There will also be a DJ and sweet station included in this cost. A photographer will be at the venue taking pictures throughout the evening and a link will be sent after the event should you want to purchase images. We cannot guarantee students without photo consent may not be captured in the background of other students photos, if this a concern please contact Mrs Johnson.

It should be possible for all those who wish to come to do so, but in order to finally secure the venue with confirmed numbers and plan the event properly we do need full payment in by the above date.
