Registration Attendance is at the start of the morning and afternoon (%) along with **authorised and unauthorised absence**, is shown at the top of the report.

In Year 12, on Report 1 (Settling In), a grade on **suitability for the course** is given (it is too early for a predicted grade).

When a student takes an internal assessment, the grade will appear as a column titled **Internal Assessment** on the following reports: Yr12 Full Report 2 and 3 Yr 13 Full Report 2.

The number of lessons attended/ total (out of a total number available) in the reporting period will be shown. On the Yr12 Report 1 (Settling In) this is a grade.

The **Key of 1-4** relates to suitability for the course (yr12 settling in report only), attitude, and completion of work (N, Abs and - may also be used). Headteacher award stickers are awarded for mainly a's and b's on the report but the Head of Year makes the overall decision.

1 = The teacher is very confident that this grade or higher can be attained 2 = The teacher is confident that this grade can be attained 3 = The student with some support and/or additional effort can attain this grade

The **Predicted grade based on current performance** is the level the student is currently working at. The 1, 2 and 3 are fine grades and allows the teacher to indicate a level of confidence in their prediction.

The **attitude to learning** shows the students attitude and response to the subject/lessons.

The **completion of work** shows how well they are completing work in and out of the lesson.

On the Yr 12 Report 3 and the Yr13 Report 1, the students **Predicted UCAS Grade** is shown.

Strength, Area for Improvement and Target comments are to provide feedback in areas for where they student is doing well plus areas to improve and a subject specific target to focus on.
