## **RE: Year 13 Exams**

With the exams on the horizon, I am writing to clarify the arrangements for Year 13 students in the upcoming months.

The Year 13 final leavers assembly will take place on Friday 10<sup>th</sup> May during period three. Students will remain in timetabled lessons until the end of the day on Friday 17<sup>th</sup> May. The only exception is if students have an exam during the week of Monday 13<sup>th</sup> – Friday 17<sup>th</sup> they are allowed to take the day prior to the exam as study leave. After the 17<sup>th</sup> May, all students will be granted exam leave. This means that they are not expected to be in school after this date. However, teachers will still be available during normal timetabled lessons and normal study facilities will also be available. If students do come into school, they will need to sign/scan in and out.

From next week attendance at Additional Studies lessons will be no longer be compulsory, however all students will be given a slot to attend a brief 1-1 meeting with Mrs Stuart or Miss Gilbert, to ensure they have access to all relevant resources and to see if they need any additional support over the coming months.

'A' level exam results will be available to Year 13 from 8.00am onwards on Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> August in the Sixth Form Common Room. The Sixth Form team will be available to offer advice to students at this time should they need it regarding their university applications or next steps.

We will be asking all Year 13 students to complete an online form during registration, supplying us with their intended destination after they leave Farlingaye. This information is important for all students but crucial for students going to university as it covers everything, they may need on results day should things not go according to plan and helps us to deal quickly with any situation that may arise.

I would also like to invite all students to join our network of alumni students. We really do encourage all student to stay in touch with us, to share successes and of course allow us to continue to provide any assistance with applications as required.
