We are delighted to announce that there is an upcoming UCAS convention, being held at University Campus, Suffolk on **Tuesday 9th June 2026 from 11.00am – 13.00pm**. This is an exciting opportunity to see stands from over 100 different universities and degree apprenticeship providers, each promoting their own courses and campuses. Having attended similar conventions before, I am sure that all students will find the experience useful. It will give them an opportunity to speak and gather course details from university staff. They will also be able to gain information about accommodation and facilities for future reference.
