Dear Parent/Carer

RE: Non School Uniform Day – Friday 13th February

We are writing to inform you of a fundraising initiative to support one of our Sixth Form students, following a serious accident that has had a significant impact on his life.

Ryan is a student in Year 12 and a member of the wider Woodbridge community. Prior to his accident, he was an active young person who participated in a range of sports and activities including skateboarding, rugby and football.

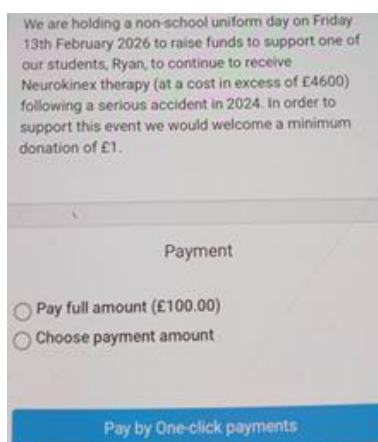
In the summer of 2024, shortly after completing his GCSEs, Ryan sustained a severe spinal injury. He required an extended period of hospital treatment at Ipswich Hospital, before being transferred to Stoke Mandeville Hospital for specialist spinal care. As a result of his injury, Ryan is now a wheelchair user and is undergoing long-term rehabilitation.

Since returning home in February 2025, Ryan has been receiving ongoing neuro-rehabilitation at Neurokinex, a UK charitable organisation that provides specialist, activity-based rehabilitation for individuals with spinal cord injuries. This therapy focuses on improving strength, function and independence and plays an important role in Ryan's recovery and long-term outcomes.

Ryan will need to continue this specialist rehabilitation. However, the costs associated with therapy, travel and related support place a considerable financial burden on his family.


To help raise funds to support Ryan's next block of rehabilitation, we will be holding a non-school uniform day on Friday 13th February. Funds raised will contribute towards further Neurokinex therapy, which will allow him to take part in an 8-week block of treatment. The cost of which is in excess of £4600.

Donations can be made via parent pay, I have attached an image to support this process, the system does not allow donations to be made over £1 unless it is step up as below. Therefore, please do click on the choose payment amount to make a donation of £1 or more.
