**Thrills and Spills (Pleasurewood Hills/Go Ape) Thursday 14<sup>th</sup>/Friday 15<sup>th</sup> July 2022**

This letter is to confirm that your son / daughter has a place on the **Thrills and Spills (Pleasurewood Hills/Go Ape)** activity on Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> July and Friday 15<sup>th</sup> July 2022, during Activities Week.

On one of the days we will be visiting Pleasurewood Hills [Home Page - Pleasurewood Hills](#). Your child should be at the bus park by 9am, allowing plenty of time for a departure time of 9.10am. The coach will return to school by the end of the school day. As part of the cost, all students will be given a band on arrival which will give them access to the rides at the theme park. Lunch is not included and students should either bring a packed lunch or money to buy lunch.

On the other day we will be going to Go Ape [High Lodge Thetford Forest Activities | Go Ape](#), an outdoor venue offering high ropes/zip wire and lots of exciting activities. We will be participating in the high ropes plus and the board games or team building whilst at the centre. Your child should arrive at the bus park in plenty of time for a departure time of 9.10am. The coach will return to school by the end of the school day. Your son/daughter should bring in a packed lunch on this day.

Before paying for the trip **please read the attached document** which is the disclaimer form that a member of staff will be signing on the day of the Go Ape activity on your behalf. Please note that by making a payment for the trip, you will be confirming that you have read the risk awareness/disclaimer form and are happy for your child to participate.

As parents you need to be aware that, as with all school trips, there is an element of risk. Please can I remind parents/carers of children with any conditions that require medication, to bring this along each day. If the school needs to be aware of any significant new medical information, please contact us before the trip.

Parents should be aware that it is school policy that participation in a trip will be dependent on staff feeling confident that your son/daughter will behave appropriately. In particular, poor behaviour between now and the date of the trip is likely to result in your child being withdrawn from the trip. The decision of the Headteacher on this matter is final.

Please note the payments deadline date is **Friday June 24<sup>th</sup> 2022**. Any student who hasn't paid by this date will be removed from the trip and will have to choose another activity from the available activities.

Nearer the time of the trip, you child will be allocated a day that he/she will be going to each of the two different venues.
