Dear Parent/Carer,

I am contacting you about an exciting opportunity for employment this summer for anyone currently at university who is studying (or has an A level in) Mathematics, Physics, Computing or MFL.

Farlingaye are once more part of a government scheme working to offer undergraduate internships in teaching for 3 weeks in the summer term. We're offering a programme that will provide a taster of what it's like to be a teacher, work in a school and engage with young people. We'll give those involved some classroom experience and get them involved with students in a range of opportunities and situations. It's a paid internship of **£300** a week, meaning if they complete 3 weeks with us it's **£900** for them to help with those sometimes-expensive summer plans and living costs for next year.

Undergraduates are eligible to apply if they are an undergraduate on a degree which is focused on any of the sciences, maths, engineering, computing or MFL and they are potentially interested in teaching at a later date. This doesn't commit anyone to anything, nor does it mean they have to explore teaching in the future. To repeat this doesn't tie them into anything in the future, or even exploring teaching beyond the 3 weeks.

The application process will be very straightforward and hopefully the exciting opportunity we are offering will give a summer job with a difference and potentially encourage some of the next generation to consider a future career in teaching.

The programme will start on Monday 26th June 2023 and the closing date for applications is Friday 17th March 2023.
