Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope you had a wonderful weekend.

I am writing to inform you about an upcoming project that may impact travel to and from Farlingaye. We have been notified by the local authorities that there will be significant disruption to the road infrastructure on Ransom Road due to the installation of fibre broadband in the next few weeks.

This construction work is anticipated to commence in the next week or so. During this period, traffic flow along Ransom Road will likely be affected, potentially causing delays and inconvenience for anyone accessing the school site. Therefore, I wanted to inform parents and carers and request that, wherever possible, you avoid driving down Ransom Road. Instead, please consider using alternative routes or suitable nearby locations for drop-off and pick-up.

Additionally, can I kindly remind parents and carers that unless drop-off arrangements have been pre-arranged with the SEN department, driving onto the school site at the beginning or end of the school day is not permitted. With so many students travelling to and from school either on foot or by bike, we really want to keep our site as safe as possible and limit unnecessary congestion that can occur.

We understand that this may cause inconvenience, and we appreciate your cooperation and understanding during this time.
