Macbeth Screening at the Riverside Cinema – 4th and 5th March

We are pleased to offer students the opportunity to see a live screening of David Tennant in Shakespeare's 'Macbeth'. The Riverside cinema are showing a screening exclusively for Farlingaye High School students. This is a great opportunity for students to develop their understanding of this GCSE set text ahead of the summer examinations.

Depending on the student's side of the year, the trip will take place on either Tuesday 4th or Wednesday 5th March. We will leave school at 9:15 am and walk to the cinema. The screening should be finished by 1.00 pm allowing students to return for their third lesson.

For the trip to run we will require parents to give a voluntary contribution of £9 per student. This will cover their ticket, staffing and insurance costs. Please make payment via ParentPay by **Wednesday 26th February**.

As parents/carers, you need to be aware that as with all school trips, there is an element of risk. On this particular trip, students will be travelling on foot to the cinema and need to be vigilant of traffic hazards, keeping to the pavement and checking before crossing the road.
