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Year 11 Virtual Parents' and Carers' Consultation Evening – Online Appointment Booking

Dear Parent/Carer of (student forename/student surname/reg.)

Following the ongoing success of online Consultation Evenings and given overwhelming positive feedback from parents and carers we have decided to continue to provide teachers' appointments virtually, through our existing Parents Evening booking system.

I would therefore like to invite you to attend our Year 11 Virtual Parents' and Carers' Consultation Evening on **Thursday 2nd February 2023**, from 4:30pm to 7:00pm.

We are opening bookings at 7pm on Wednesday 25th January 2023. Please visit <https://farlingaye.schoolcloud.co.uk/> or, if you have already downloaded our School Gateway app, please follow the Parents Evening link. This allows you to choose your own appointment times with teachers and you will receive an email confirming your appointments. You can book appointments using a PC/laptop, mobile phone or tablet. However we recommend using a PC/laptop if possible to make bookings, as this allows you to see all the teacher availability on one screen.

If you experience any problems logging on please refer to the attached Parents' Guide in the first instance. Should you wish to make any changes after this date or if you have any queries, please contact Mrs Newman in the Data Office or via email inewman@farlingaye.suffolk.sch.uk.

Due to technical reasons only those parents and carers who are listed on our SIMS system as Priority 1 contact can make bookings via the online booking system. To log in, you will need to enter:

Parent's/Carer's Title
Parent's/Carer's Forename
Parent's/Carer's Surname
Parent's/Carer's email address
Student's First Name
Student's Surname
Date of Birth (this will be your child's date of birth)

At Farlingaye, we recognise that it is very important that all those with parental responsibility for students are treated equally, and therefore that anyone with parental responsibility is given the opportunity to attend Consultation Evenings and discuss how their child is progressing. Each video call can now involve up to 2 parents/guardians, including any non-resident parents. After the parent makes their bookings, they should click the *'Invite Parent/Guardian' button*, then enter the email address of the additional parent/guardian. This sends an invite that grants access to the call. The additional parent can then click on the link in the email to join the appointments. Full details of how this works can be found at the foot of the parent guide.

In order to make video calls you will need to have a device with a microphone and speaker and a compatible web browser, and you may find that your smartphone will provide you with the easiest and most effective combination of these elements. However, if you don't have a front-facing camera, you should use a laptop or computer with a webcam. If you do not have the facility to video call, you will be able to turn the video option off and have a conversation with the teacher.
