Dear Parent/Carer,

As we approach the final stretch before the Business Studies exams on Friday 9th January 2026, I wanted to take this opportunity to update you on the resources available to support your child's revision and preparation.

We understand that the period leading up to exams can be stressful for both students and parents, and it is our goal to ensure that every student has access to the tools and guidance needed to succeed. To this end, we have a range of resources and support mechanisms in place to help students achieve their full potential:

1. Revision Materials

On Teams there are all the lesson PowerPoints, an interactive revision programme along with videos and exam questions. These materials cover key topics in the syllabus and offer practice questions to help students familiarise themselves with the exam format.

We strongly encourage students to work through past papers under timed conditions to improve their exam technique, these are available from me and I am happy to mark any they complete.

2. Additional Revision Sessions


In the weeks leading up to the exams, we will be offering extra revision sessions during a Wednesday lunchtime. These sessions will provide students with the chance to receive targeted help on areas they find challenging.

3. One-on-One Support

If your child feels they need more personalised support, they are welcome to arrange a one-on-one meeting with me. These sessions can be particularly helpful for addressing specific questions or revising particular topics. We encourage students to take advantage of this opportunity to ensure they are fully prepared for the exams.

We strongly believe that with the right preparation and support, all students have the potential to do well in their exams. We would like to thank you for your ongoing support and encourage you to continue to motivate your child throughout their revision process.

From January we will be embarking on our final coursework unit where there will be strict deadlines which must be met in order to complete the course. These will be set via Teams and students are welcome to use SF5 during lunchtimes where I will be available for additional support.
