Year 13 Prom – Friday 30th June 6.45pm – 11.00pm

We are excited to confirm that the Year 13 Prom to celebrate the end of Sixth Form will be held at Unit 16 on Tuddenham Road, Ipswich. It is a very well-regarded venue for proms, weddings and other large functions. The excellent package includes a welcome drink, two course meal and disco. It was a challenge for the Prom Committee to choose the options from such an extensive menu, but the carefully selected choices will hopefully appeal to all students.

Main Courses

- **Chicken stuffed with asparagus**, wrapped in smoked bacon and puff pastry, served on a leek and cheesy mask cake with roasted root vegetables and peas, accompanied with a sparkling white wine and tarragon sauce.
- **Pan fried Seabass** seasoned with lemon and lime, crusted skin placed on a roasted couscous drizzled with a French vinaigrette and garnished with fresh watercress.
- **Butternut squash and zucchini lasagne** topped with smoked cheddar, accompanied with rosemary and garlic focaccia and a Greek Salad (**V, can also be served as a vegan option**).

Desserts

- **Dark chocolate and salted caramel brownie** with white chocolate and honeycomb ice cream
- **Raspberry roulade** with fruit and coulis
- **Sticky toffee pudding (VG, GF)**

Although various other details are yet to be confirmed by our Prom Committee, we are now in a position to confirm the price and payment details for this occasion.

The cost of the Prom this year will be **£45** which will need to be **paid in full by Wednesday 19th April**. Payments can only be made using ParentPay where menu choices will also need to be selected. It should be possible for all those who wish to come to do so but in order to finally secure the venue with confirmed numbers and plan the event properly we do need full payment in by the above date. The Prom Committee will then continue with their planning in earnest to ensure everyone involved has a fantastic evening and a wonderful final celebration.
